SUGGESTED DISCUSSION POINTS FROM JANUARY 6, 2019 SERMON

The Fruit of the Spirit Galatians 5:16-26

- 1. Talk about the significance of the foreshadowing of the Holy Spirit in the OT Goodbye Egypt, Hello Promised Land (Look in depth at Haggai 2:4-5, Nehemiah 9:19-20 and Isaiah 63:11-14)
- 2. Discuss the ongoing reality of the war within (James 4:1-2; Romans 7:22-33)
- 3. How is it possible we can turn from sin and be led by the Spirit? (Galatians 5:16-18, 24)
- 4. What struck you the most in the section on 'The deeds of the flesh?" (vv. 19-21)
- 5. What lesson or reminder did you need the most in the section on 'The Fruit of the Spirit?" (vv. 22-23)
- 6. How can you see the fruit growing in your life?
- 7. Describe the climate (environment) in which the Spirit could most effectively grow fruit in your life.
- 8. What will walking by the Spirit involve for you this week?
