Questions Jesus Asks You

Does Jesus Forbid All Judging?
Matthew 7:1-6
(Pew Bible p. 963)

One of the most *well-known* and most *abused* verses in the Bible:
Judge not, that you be not judged, Matthew 7:1 NKJV

Jesus' Question: *Why do you look at the speck that is in your brother's eye, but do not notice the log that is in your own eye?*

Matthew 7:3

What Jesus is NOT saying: Never exercise any evaluations.

What Jesus IS SAYING:

Replace constant criticism with humble discernment.

We do not have infallible abilities of judgment, but we can always quote what the Judge has said.
