Flourishing, Faithful and Fruitful Galatians 2:1-10

- 1. The other Apostles didn't give Paul his Gospel but they did endorse it (2:7,9). Why is this important?
- 2. How did Jesus' death break down the barriers between Jews and Gentiles? (See Ephesians 2:11-22)
- 3. God sent Peter to take the Gospel to his fellow Jews and He sent Paul to take the Gospel to the non-Jews. To whom has God sent you?
- 4. Describe your particular ministry at this point in your life? (Church, Family)
- 5. How can you encourage others to flourish in ministry? How can you cheer others on rather than to compete with them?
- 6. In what way can you incorporate 'remembering the poor' and vulnerable in your ministry?
- 7. What hinders fruitfulness in your life in ministering to others?
- 8. Things that are out of your control require faithfulness but some things you can tackle head on for the sake of fruitfulness. Is there anything you need to tackle head on?
- 9. Sometimes in order to be **fruitful** and **faithful** you have to stand firm and say, "No. I will not compromise." Is there a certain area you need to stand firm?
- 10. Sometimes you need to change to be more fruitful. Is there anything you need to change?
