SUGGESTED DISCUSSION POINTS FROM NOVEMBER 18, 2018 SERMON

Fully Known and Fully Loved

Galatians 4:8-20

1. In what sense does the Gospel bring freedom from slavery?

2. What does it mean to be “known” by God (v. 9)? Why is this an amazing thing to say?

3. How is any attempt to earn favor before God, even under the banner of religion, a form of paganism?

4. What idols are you in most danger of serving?

5. How does remembering that God knows you free you from the temptation to worship idols?

6. Why is it also important to be known and loved by those in the Body of Christ?

7. Have you become someone’s enemy by telling the truth (4:16)? Do you need to speak the truth in love to someone right now? If so, explain why.

8. In verse 19 we see Paul’s passion for spiritual growth of the church Galatia. In what ways can you foster that kind of love fellow believers?
