SUGGESTED DISCUSSION POINTS FROM APRIL 26, 2020 SERMON

Grace, Peace and Joy Philippians 1:1-2

What verses in Philippians have been meaningful to you in the past?

Discuss how church planting is crucial to the spread of the Gospel?

The imagery of slavery was an important description used of early Christians. Why would they use such a horrific image that was terrible during the Roman times just as our times?

Describe how Jesus is both Lord and a gracious Master.

Given who Christ is, why is it a privilege, rather than oppressive, to be one of His 'bond-servants?'

Discuss ways that as a slave of Christ you can serve others?

What does it mean that all believers are saints? Is that what you grew up believing?

How are you as a 'saint,' living a set-apart life in your particular place and time, in what you pursue and what you refrain from?

Who is the source of grace, peace and even joy?

What is meant by grace and peace?

Can you have peace without grace? Why not?

Are there other places you are tempted to look to for your peace? How does the result of locating your sense of peace there compare to when you seek it in God?

What difference will 'grace to you' and 'peace from God' make to your day today and tomorrow?

How can you positively put yourself in the way of God's grace, peace and joy?
