Romans 8:26-30

Do you believe that God is working for your good in your suffering?

Why is it important to be rooted deep in the truth of God before suffering hits?

Have you ever come before the Lord in prayer and you are not quite sure what you are to pray for? You really can't discern His will in a certain situation and you just don't know what's appropriate to pray. (Romans 8:26)

In your groaning's and confusion before God, the Holy Spirit fills the gap and intercedes for you exactly in line with the will of God. (8:27)
Describe how that makes you feel?

Read Romans 8:28 and reflect upon Joseph's conclusion to his story in Genesis 50:20.

How does God work for your good in all things? What is meant by good? (Read 8:29 and discuss the good of becoming more like His Son)

Why is it hard to believe God is working for your good when you are in pain?

Discuss each link of the Golden Chain in Romans 8:29-30

Justified

Glorified

God is working all things for good.
