Redemption Ruth 4:1-12

What does redemption mean?
How is Boaz, the kinsman-redeemer a picture of Christ?
How is Boaz shrewd in the way he conducts negotiations?
What do you think of the first-in-line redeemer's reason for saying no? How common and sensible is his reasoning?
Which type of reasons do you tend to consider when making decisions, big or small, in your life? Explain.
Discuss the following: "In your life you will be faced with choices where you can choose to step in and make things better or choose to bow out. And to some extent if you bow out, that is OK and you will not be condemned. But like "Mr. So and So," your faith is not going to be held up to be modeled by others. "
How can the redemption of Jesus motivate you to act in redemptive ways towards others?
