Sovereign Refuge Ruth 2:1-13

Begin your time together discussing Proverbs 16:9, "The heart of man plans his way, but the Lord establishes his steps." Have you found this to be true in your life? Explain.

Describe some of the godly traits to emulate in Boaz.

Describe some of the godly traits to emulate in Ruth.

What obstacles to faith did Ruth have to overcome?

Read Ruth 2:3. Discuss how the text tips you off to God's sovereignty by saying, "and she happened to come..."

Discuss Proverbs 20:24, "A man's steps are from the Lord; how then can man understand his way?"

Read Leviticus 19:9-10 and then Read Ruth 2:9 - How is Boaz offering Ruth above and beyond what she deserved or was required of the law?

Read Ruth 2:12 and explain the idea of seeking refuge under God's wings.

Discuss the phrase, "Where the Eagle Moves I will move."

Read Matthew 23:37 and rejoice in the fact that we are a people under the wings of God in the finished work of Jesus.
