1) Younger son – sins of the flesh,	vv. 11-24
Elder son – sins of the spirit,	vv. 25-32

Repeated Cycle: Lost - Seek - Found - Rejoice

The final verse (v. 32) "answers" the opening verses (vv. 1-3) but leaves the issue "open" for each of us to respond.
