Verses to 'catch' on: Matthew 1:21-23:

21 She will bear a Son; and you shall call His name <u>Jesus</u>, for He will <u>save His people from their sins</u>. 22 Now all this took place to fulfill what was spoken by the Lord through the prophet: 23 "BEHOLD, THE VIRGIN SHALL BE WITH CHILD AND SHALL BEAR A SON, AND **THEY SHALL CALL HIS NAME** <u>IMMANUEL</u>, "which translated means, "<u>GOD WITH US</u>."

JESUS – The Jesus of the Bible
