- 2. <u>SADNESS</u> (Role of feelings): v. 33, Jesus was deeply moved in spirit and troubled
- 3. TEARS (Expressing the grief): v. 35, Jesus wept
- 4. <u>GOD</u> (Aggressively pursue Him & His ways by faith): vv. 40-42 *If you believe, you will see the glory of God...Jesus said, "Father..."*
